Notes, report:

On December 11, 2020, the following met in the "Children's Cultural Center Belgrade" ("Dečji kulturni centar Beograd"): Prof. Dragan Marić, MA / Director, Ms. Nataša Olimpiki, Mr. Miloš Bajić / Legal Associate and Mr. Dalibor Stojanović / Program Organizer-Producer.

Ms. Olimpiki presented the work of our humanitarian organization, as well as the wishes and the goals. She also gave a proposal for a joint performance of an international humanitarian play, which was enthusiastically accepted.

On December 14, 2020, the following met in the "Children's Cultural Center Belgrade":

Ms. Nataša Olimpiki, Mr. Dragan Marić and Mr. Miloš Bajić.

Ms. Olimpiki presented her desire include children and young people to the play (to teach and motivate them online at the moment: once a week they would report online: how to write a screenplay (with experienced writers, how to write a dramaturgical story), scenography (they will learn about creativity and art), about directing (how to create a play from the beginning to the end, how to develop organizational and leadership skills), about costume design (how to design and sew costumes), about acting and performance (performance in the play itself), about dance, about filming (editing, framing, aesthetics), PR (internet message design, advertising, performances).

The premiere is scheduled for May 2021.

Ms. Olimpiki suggested that celebrities should be included in the play, so they would visit the working team every week at the time of creation and thus be involved in the whole process (artists, professional actors, musicians, athletes, journalists, high representatives, supporters). She would like everyone to be invited to cooperate, to get support in the republics of the former Yugoslavia, because Ms. Olimpiki is in Belgrade to help in the current emergency conditions that prevail in the world. In her opinion, the borders should not be closed, instead we must be in solidarity, so we can help each other. We should be united, especially when it comes to the health of children and people in general! The basic message of the play is: Act with LOVE towards children, other people and the nature of which we depend, so we can start returning to a simple way of life, old values, respecting all living beings in the world!

Mr. Minja Subota / President of the Board of Directors of the "Children's Cultural Center Belgrade" also joined the meeting. Ms. Olimpiki had the honor to meet the famous composer, who was visiting the Center at the time. She also presented the organization and her idea to him. Also, they were happy to talk about common friends in Slovenia and Serbia. Ms. Olimpiki was handed a Protocol of Cooperation for review, which she signed the next day and sent back. This educational and socially engaged project, in addition to developing an affinity for art, also means confirming the rights of children and youth to culture and education in the regions of the former Yugoslavia.

On December 18, 2020, the following met at the "Children's Cultural Center Belgrade:

Ms. Nataša Olimpiki, Mr. Dragan Marić, Mr. Dalibor Stojanović, Mr. Milos Bajić and Mr. Paul Leonard Murray / Director of "The Belgrade English Language Youth Theatre", actor and pedagogue.

Mr. Marić asked Ms. Olimpiki to present our organization, idea, visions to Mr. Leonard Murray and invite him to cooperate as well.

After the meeting, the employees of the "Children's Cultural Center Belgrade" joined the pleasant gathering.

In the next few days, a draft of the *humanitarian play Olimpiki* was created. Ms. Olimpiki's idea is "infused" into the concept of the work of the "Children's Cultural Center Belgrade", which can with their experience and knowledge enable the beginning of a demanding performance and start work and cooperation among selected young actors. Ms. Olimpiki is happy that she brought new energy to the "Children's Cultural Center Belgrade", which is currently working to a limited extent due to strict measures.

All collected financial resources, which will be collected at the premiere from both sponsors and donors, are intended for the "Center for Social Work Belgrade".

Nataša Olimpiki gives the initiative and thus invites the President of the Republic of Slovenia, Borut Pahor, and the President of the Republic of Serbia, Aleksandar Vučić, to take over the honorary patronage of the play.
